- 6. Information Item: Director of Library Services Report
 - Shorewood Public Library received a \$500 donation from the Sally J. Lewis and Kathleen M. Rivera Fund. The grant designated "for where it's needed most" will likely go towards 2025 collection development and/or programming.
 - Assistant Director Noah Weckwerth coordinated a library Shelf Read Week. All scheduled clerks and librarians shelf read at least one hour a day. Shelf reading involves reviewing at each and every item on the library's shelves, ensuring that materials are in the correct place.
 - Librarians will be coordinating three winter reading programs for children (sponsored by Kiwanis North Shore Milwaukee), teens, and adults (sponsored by the Friends of Shorewood Library). All winter reading programs will run from Tuesday, January 21, 2025 through Saturday, March 8, 2025.

• January 18 - May 3, 2025, all Milwaukee County public libraries will be participating in the Great Library Treasure Hunt. This program is a fun, scavenger hunt-style event that encourages patrons and community members to visit multiple libraries, write down their favorite thing about each library, and get their map stamped for a chance to win prizes. The program is intended to raise awareness of libraries as destinations along with highlighting the county's amazing library buildings and resources. Shorewood Public Library staff will use this opportunity to highlight our services, and to sign new patrons up with a library card.

This system-wide program is being coordinated by Milwaukee County Federated Library System (MCFLS) staff.
